



Thank you for participating in our annual Holiday Lights Dash. This event is a family friendly 1+ mile walk or run through the forest at Lincoln Park. We are excited about our new location this year! Also, we are starting an hour earlier than in years past. Start time for the event is at 2:00 pm at the H Street entrance to Lincoln Park. For those of you not familiar with the location, the address is 1800 H Street, Blaine, WA, 98230. Costumes are encouraged!! You will see the Lollipop Queen, Princess Frostine, Lord Licorice and Elf on your adventure!

Day of the Event: Please **check in** with our registration booth to pick up your race bib and food voucher. You will find our event trailer located in the parking lot at the Blaine International Center, 1733 H Street Blaine, WA. We will be parked near the Dollar Tree Parking area. Here are some things that may be helpful prior to the event:

This race is not timed and there is no prize for first place. We would like to point out that there are potential hazards in the woods. Please be aware of the following hazards:

- Leaves are slippery
- Dirt / Gravel can be loose in areas
- Bridges or boardwalks can be slippery when wet
- Roots and rocks just above the surface can be tripping hazards, please be aware of what is under your feet.
- Please stay on designated trail.
- Hills – there are a few hills along the course, please use caution when going down one.

REMINDER: The giant candy canes, gingerbread men and lollipops are for decoration only!

Event Parking:

There will be no parking available at Lincoln Park. However, we recommend you park at the Cost Cutter Parking Lot, the Blaine International Center, 1733 H Street Blaine, WA. Please keep in mind there are many available spots in front of the old Rite Aid Store next to Dollar Tree. Please be respectful of businesses that may be open during the event.
