



## Application for Community Program Support

As part of our goals, the Blaine-Birch Bay Park and Recreation District #2 (BBBPRD2) is interested in assisting organizations with their recreation and leisure activities located in the Blaine-Birch Bay area by offering financial support to numerous projects, organizations, and other government agencies.

Community Program Support applications must be submitted no later than December 31, for the following fiscal year. The BBBPRD2 plans for all expenditures in annual budgets to be finalized and approved at the February Board meeting of the fiscal year. These requests for support will be reviewed and approved in a timely manner by the Board of Commissioners. Requests that miss the December 31 deadline may still be considered for approval and funding during current fiscal year if finances from the reserve fund are available and if deemed valuable by Commissioners.

All requests for financial support for community programs from BBBPRD2 shall be made in writing from the organization or individual making the request on the District form. The form is on page 2 of this document along with the list of materials and documentation needed for the application. After the request has been submitted, no motion to approve funding shall be made by Commissioners prior to the next scheduled business meeting. Presentations to the Board will be scheduled for January /February of the fiscal year for which the request is being made. Board meetings are held the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of each month. The District will notify past and new recipients of the community via the local newspaper and other social media outlets each year, so their organizations can submit requests for consideration. If the request is approved, an inter-local agreement will be administered by the District and signed by the individual recipients. Any insurance certificates naming the District as additional insured must be submitted to the District prior to the issuance of funds.

It should be noted that to retain support eligibility in the future, it is essential the District be notified of any major amendments to current plans as they occur. An incorrect or incomplete plan may impact your project's evaluation.
